So, you decide to share your house with a dog. A few things that you need to consider right off the bat.
(partager) (dès le départ)

What dog is right for you? You need to consider your lifestyle and expectations for a dog.
(convenable) (attentes)

This is the most important part of choosing a dog and is the best way to avoid problems with the dog
(éviter)

down the road.
(en bas de la route = plus tard)

Many times people call me in to solve behavioral problems that really aren't behavioral problems.
(me font venir) (comportementaux)

It's really breed problems. Somebody has an Australian Shepherd and they are frustrated that the dog
(problèmes de race du chien)

has high energy or is jumping up on the counters and things like that.
(les comptoirs de la cuisine)

Take into consideration what it is you're looking for. How much exercise does the dog need? What are
(cherchez)

the grooming needs and what are the training needs for a certain breed? And then size and shape.
(les besoins de toilettage) (la taille et la forme)

What kind of dog do you want? Don't just pick a dog on impulse and don't just pick a dog with your
(sorte) (sur un coup de tête)

heart. Make sure you're picking a dog with your brain and picking a dog with common sense.
(Soyez certain)

So if you want, you know, a tea-cup Chihuahua that would be great, but don't expect to necessarily
(qui peut se mettre dans une tasse à thé) (super)

run an agility course with it. Likewise, if you want a dog who's going to sit around and watch a game
(faire un parcours d'agilité) (De la même manière) (s'asseoir pour se relaxer en regardant un match)

with you, perhaps an Australian Shepherd is not necessarily the right dog or a golden retriever.

It's going to require a lot of running and playing and exercise and training.
(il va demander)

There are a lot of great resources online where you can look into different breeds and that would be
(étudier)

the first step in finding the right dog for you.
(le premier pas, la première démarche)
